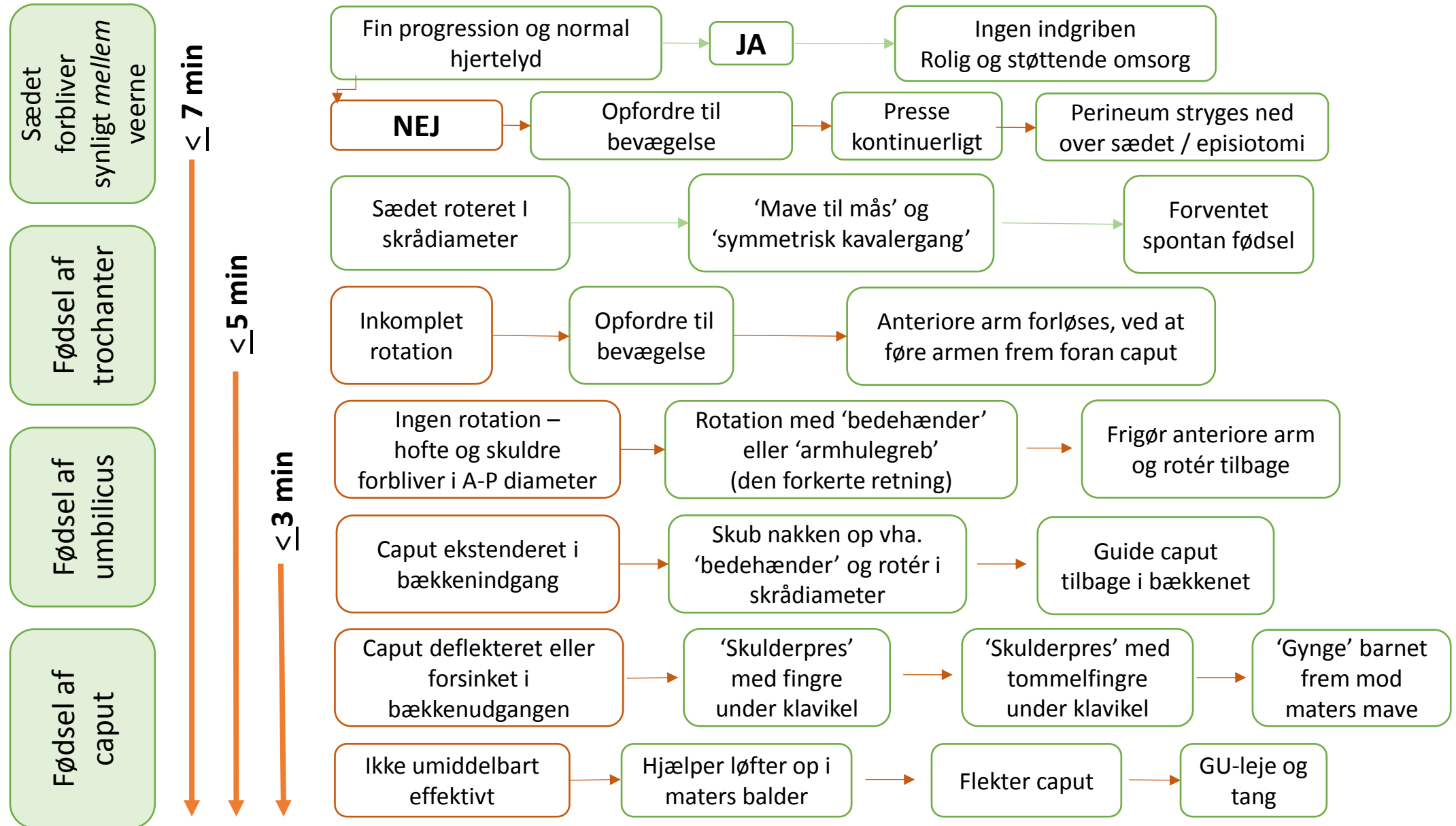


Oprejst UK- fødsel flowchart
